Skripsi ini menganalisa tentang hambatan yang dihadapi UN Women dalam mengatasi kekerasan terhadap perempuan khususnya di Mesir yang menjadi salah satu negara di kawasan dunia Arab yang masih menempatkan perempuan sebagai kelompok termarginalisasi. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui apa saja upaya yang telah dilaksanakan UN Women dan hambatan apa saja yang dihadapi UN Women dalam mengatasi kekerasan terhadap perempuan di Mesir. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode penelitian kualitatif dan pengumpulan data menggunakan sumber data sekunder yang didapat dari internet, buku, report, jurnal, skripsi, dan tesis. Dalam analisisnya penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif analisis. Terdapat dua konsep yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini, yaitu Organisasi Internasional dan Feminisme. Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa UN Women telah melakukan berbagai macam program dalam upayanya mengatasi kekerasan terhadap perempuan di Mesir, yaitu Program *Safe Cities, Prevention and access to essential services to end violence against women and girls, Eliminating female genital mutilation (FGM) program, Confronting pandemic-related violence against women, Women's access to justice, Tackling violence against women in the time of COVID-19*. Kampanye melalui media online melalui Youtube, seperti *Speak Up, Women's hosting and guidance shelters, I chose to Speak up, #SpeakUp Campaign 2 End VAW: Domestic Violence dan #SpeakUp Campaign to End VAW: Sexual Harassment*. Namun, dalam upayanya terdapat tiga hambatan yang dihadapi oleh UN Women, pertama patriarki dan budaya impunitas di masyarakat Mesir, kedua ketidakpastian ekonomi dan rendahnya partisipasi perempuan di pasar tenaga kerja, ketiga masih kurangnya keterwakilan perempuan di parlemen Mesir.

This thesis analyzes the obstacles faced by UN Women in overcoming violence against women, especially in Egypt, which is one of the countries in the Arab world that still places women as a marginalized group. The purpose of this research is to find out what efforts have been made by UN Women and what obstacles UN Women has faced in dealing with violence against women in Egypt. This study used qualitative research methods and data collection using secondary data sources obtained from the internet, books, reports, journals and theses. In the analysis of this research using descriptive analysis method. There are two concepts used in this study, namely International Organization and Feminism. The results of this study indicate that UN Women has carried out various programs in its efforts to overcome violence against women in Egypt, namely the Safe Cities Program, Prevention and access to essential services to end violence against women and girls, Eliminating female genital mutilation (FGM) program, Confronting pandemic-related violence against women, Women's access to justice, Tackling violence against women in the time of COVID-19. Campaigns through online media via Youtube, such as Speak Up, Women's hosting and guidance shelters, I chose to Speak up, #SpeakUp Campaign 2 End VAW: Domestic Violence and #SpeakUp Campaign to End VAW: Sexual Harassment. However, in its efforts there are three obstacles faced by UN Women, firstly patriarchy and a culture of impunity in Egyptian society, secondly economic uncertainty and low participation of women in the labor market, thirdly there is still a lack of women's representation in the Egyptian parliament.
